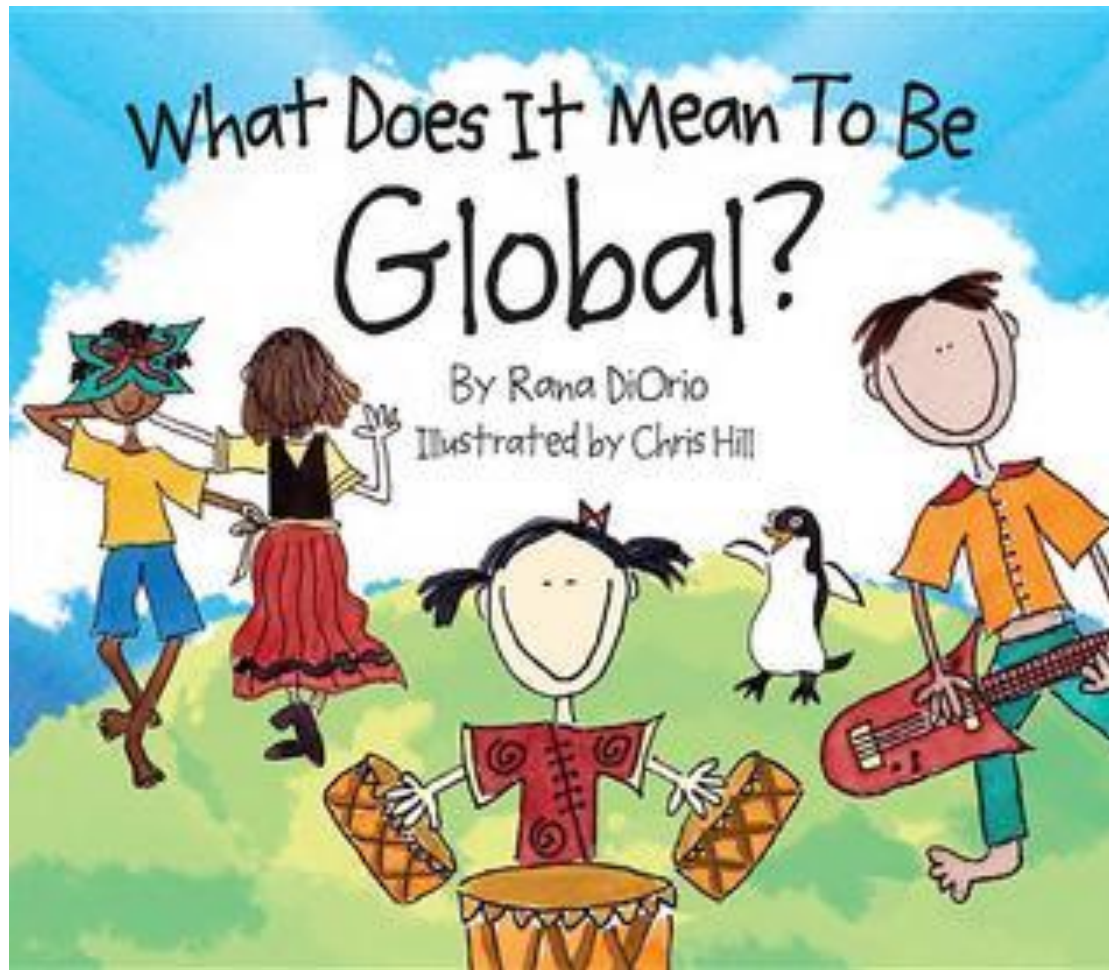


What Does It Mean To Be **Global**?

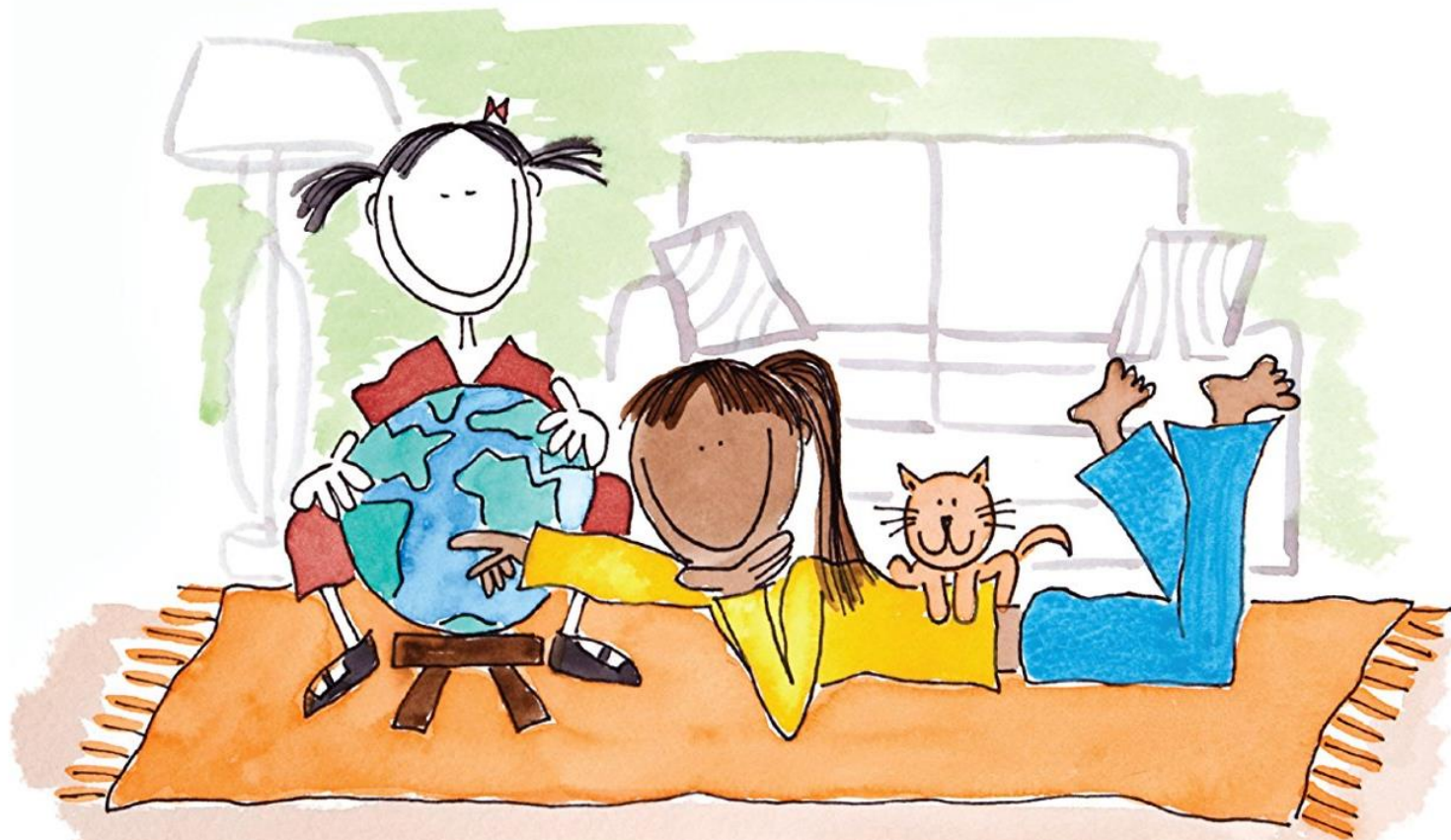


Being global means...

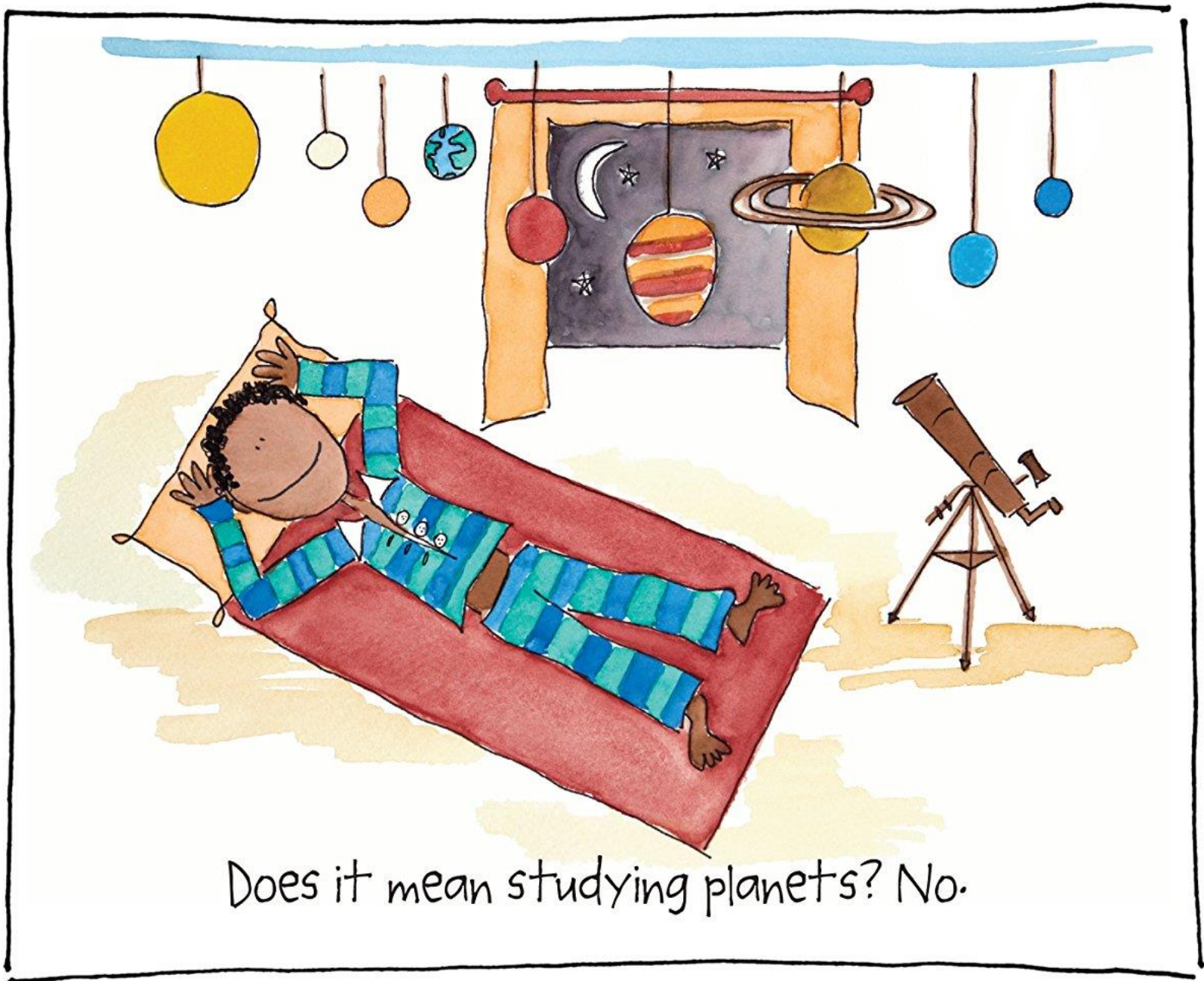
Experiencing other traditions

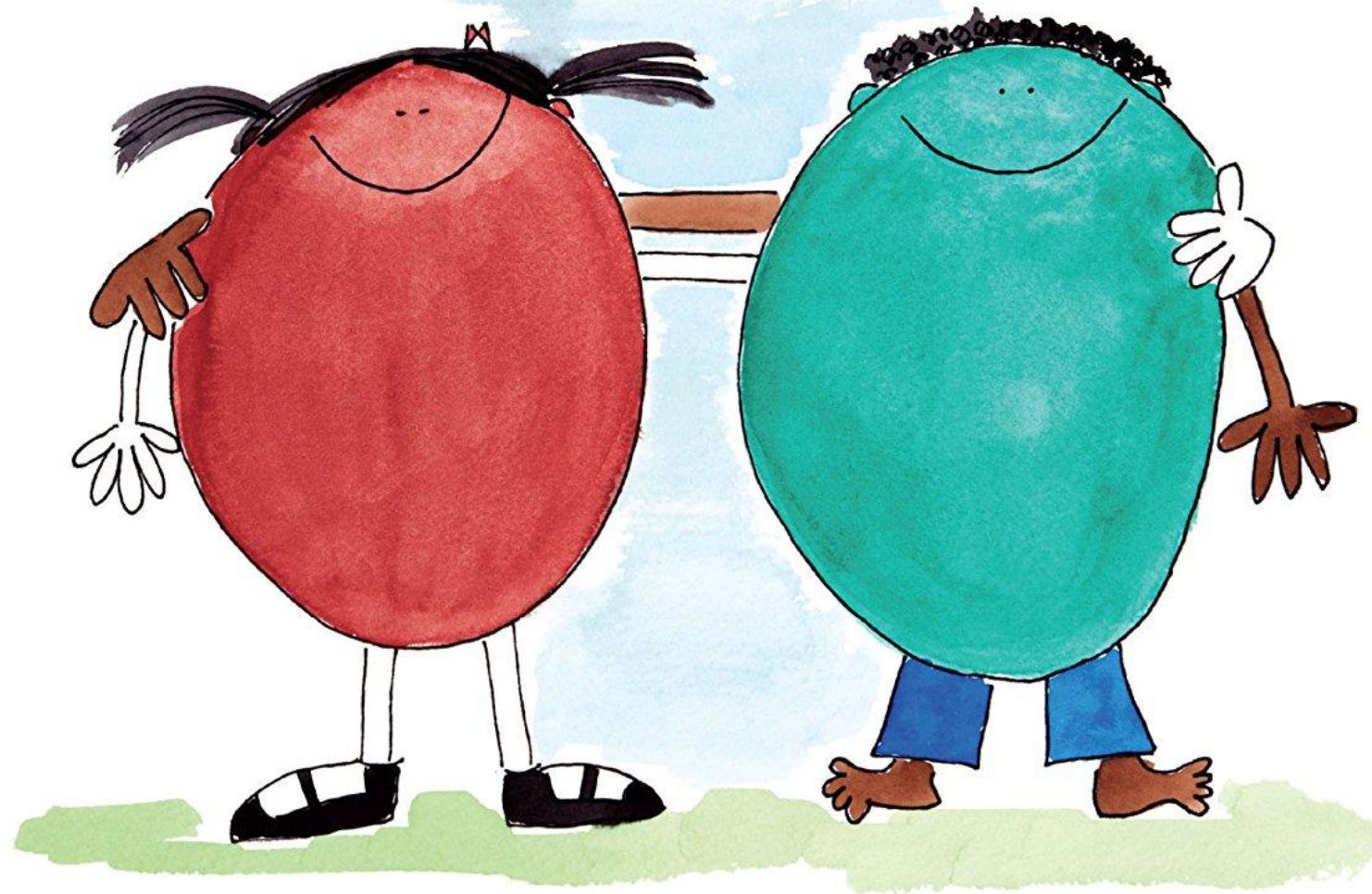
What does it mean to be global?

... listening to all different kinds of music.



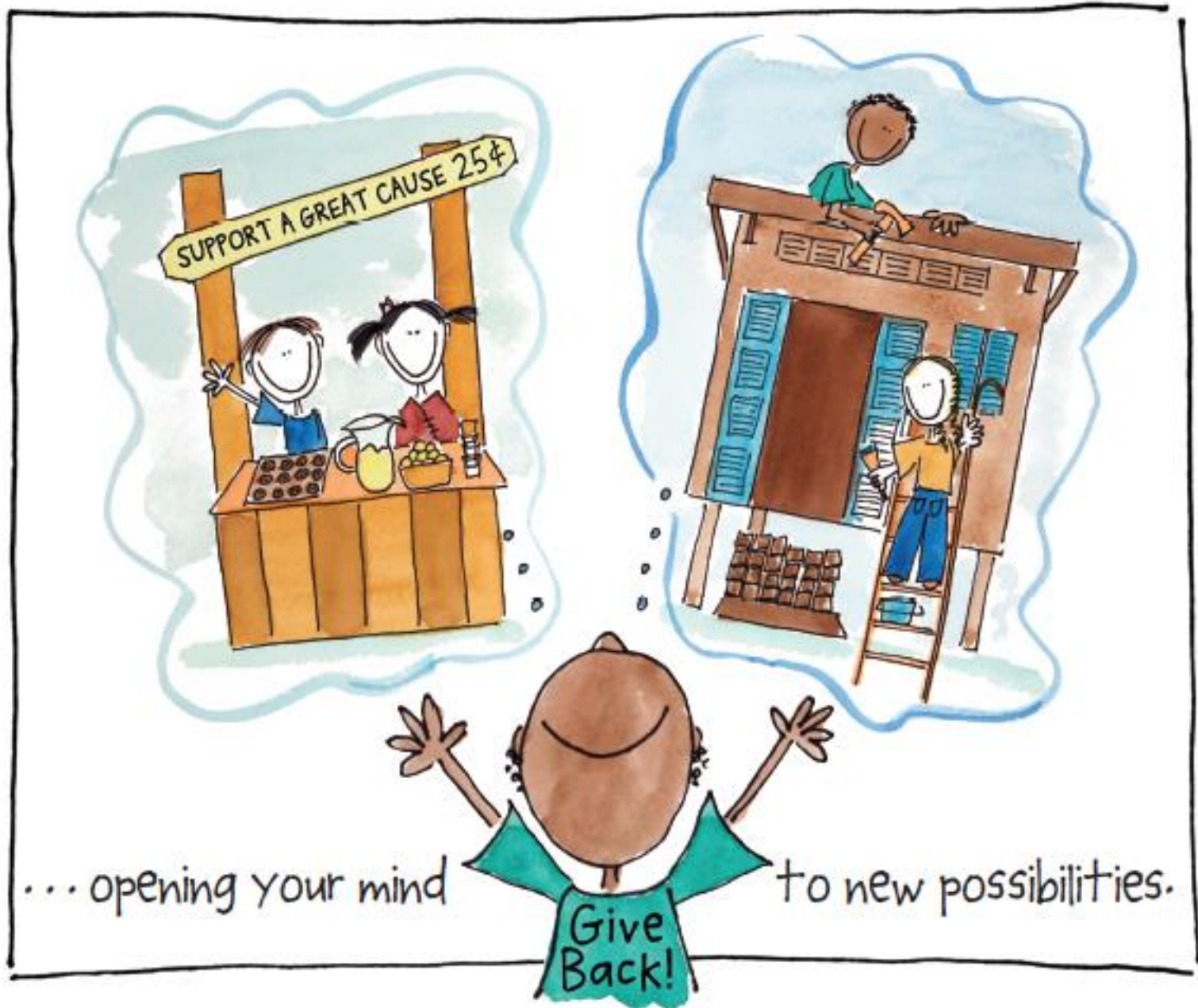
... traveling to places near and far
